







NOTE:

Additional weather seal may be required for pickups with bed caps, tailgate protectors, or liners. Add weather seal if needed to seal appropriately.











11 Close cover:




Release safety straps, and unroll cover over pickup bed. Open tailgate.






Rotate tailgate header down until both latches engage. Listen for double click.



Secure loop to hook fasteners on one side rail by pressing edge of cover along full length of rail.



Pull cover tight across width of pickup bed. Secure loop and hook fasteners on opposite side rail.







Both latches must be fully engaged!!!



- To prevent accidental release of tailgate header, ensure header is securely latched to side rails on both sides of pickup bed before driving vehicle.
- To prevent wind lift, secure loop and hook fasteners along entire length of both side rails before driving vehicle.

12 Cover tension: There is no need to adjust cover length tension. The Latch Assembly is set to the correct tension.

Any modification done to this will VOID warranty.

Keeping cover taut:

Periodically or as needed, pull cover tight across width of pickup bed, secure loop and hook on side rails.


For ease of operation, periodically clean with high pressure water to remove dirt and dust.

Cover may appear loose or relaxed in cooler or cold conditions. Cover may appear tight in warmer or hot conditions.

LATCH ASSEMBLY

13 Open cover:





To release second latch, repeat process on opposite side. Place free hand on tailgate header to control header movement on release.



Roll up cover. **Do Not** disengage loop and hook fasteners prior to rolling up cover.



Always secure cover at front of pickup bed with both safety straps when cover is open.



WARNING

Tighten clamps securely on side rails before driving vehicle, to prevent cover from blowing off.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Do not place objects on or against cover or framework.
- 2. Do not tie cargo to TruXport framework.
- 3. Never allow children or pets to occupy pickup box while cover is closed.
- 4. Cover is not airtight. Special care is required to keep cargo clean and dry.
- 5. Fabric cover won't prevent theft of contents inside truck box.
- Cover must be rolled fully open and secured with safety straps when towing vehicle backwards.
- Rolled opened cover must be tightly rolled, securely cinched down with both safety straps, and away from the cab and window. <u>DO NOT</u> STOW COVER AGAINST TRUCK CAB OR BACK WINDOW.
- Cover must be rolled fully open and secured with safety straps if any part of the tonneau cover is worn or damaged.

OWNER/USER RESPONSIBILITIES

It is the responsibility of the owner/user to read this manual and comply with the operating procedures. The owner/user is also responsible for inspecting their TruXport® cover, and for having parts repaired or replaced when worn or damaged.

Failure to follow safety instructions and warning labels could result in failure of your cover system and/or personal injury.

MESSAGES TO INSTALLER

- Always wear safety glasses and/or other necessary protective equipment when installing your TruXport®.
- These instructions are complete for most pickup models. Additional instructions are included, if required for your pickup. Please read entire manual before installing your TruXport®.

COVER MAINTENANCE

Vinyl cover can be hand washed with mild soap and water or cleaned in a car wash. Thoroughly rinse cover to remove any soap residue. Recommended to use the tested and approved Protex tonneau cleaner or any vinyl protectant made for tonneau covers. Never use any vinyl conditioners (ie, Armor All®) that contain silicone, petroleum, or citrus based products on your tonneau cover as they may crack and shrink the vinyl.
