Never work under an unsupported vehicle. 2. You will need the following tools: a. 10mm Allen Wrench b. 8mm Allen Wrench c. 13/16 Socket ADDICTIVE DESERT DE d. 13mm Socket e. 10mm Wrench f. 8mm Wrench Note: This installation requires 2 people for best results ** This kit is not compatible with OEM tie rod ends. If your tie rod ends are stock, you must order an aftermarket tie rod end kit. Our HD Off-road Tie Rod End Kit part number is AC01150299NA.**

- 3. Included in Kit:
 - a. 4 assembled calipers
 - b. 4 rotors



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Remove the front wheels.
- 2. Remove factory caliper with bracket (13/16" socket). Remove the factory brake line as well.



- 3. Carefully, remove the factory rotor from the vehicle.
- 4. Remove 8mm bolts located on the dust shield. Then remove the dust shield.

5. Install caliper adaptor, using factory bolts and red loctite.



- 6. Install the new rotor.
- 7. Place the new caliper on the vehicle using a 10mm allen wrench.



- 8. Place the **front** wheels back on the vehicle, after bleeding the calipers.
- 9. Remove the rear wheels from your vehicle.
- 10. Remove the 10mm factory caliper bolts.
- 11. Remove factory brake line using $\frac{1}{2}$ socket.



If you own a 2009-2011 F-150, step 12-24 apply to your truck. 2012-2014 these steps do not apply to your truck. 2009-2011 F-150 owners also need to order part #'s FOCL3Z-2210-C and FOCL3Z-2209-C from your local Ford dealer.

- 12. Remove rear diff cover using a 13mm socket. (see A below)
- 13. Remove 8mm bolt from differential for removal of king pin. (See B below)
- 14. Remove king pin at this time. (see C below)



15. Push axle shafts in, to reveal the "C" clips and remove.



16. At this time you will carefully pull out axle shafts.



- 17. Use 8mm allen wrench to remove sensor.
- 18. Next you will remove the emergency brake cable.






19. Remove the four 13/16" bolts located on brake bracket.



20. Install new bracket, using new hardware.



- 21. Carefully, reinstall axle shafts on vehicle.
- 22. Once the shafts are in place, install the factory "C" clip back onto vehicle. Once the "C" clip is in place, place the king pin back in the differential carrier.
- 23. Reinstall the 8mm bolt to hold king pin into place.



- 24. You are now ready to place differential cover on vehicle using Grey silicone.
- 25. Trim rear dust plate to fit new caliper.
- 26. Install your new rotor and caliper bracket using the new hardware provided in the kit.
- 27. Now you may install your new caliper using 10mm allen head.
- 28. Reinstall brake line at this time.
- 29. Place wheels back onto vehicle.
- 30. To complete this installation you will now need to bleed the brake lines.

Now step back and enjoy your new brake kit.
